- 1) **Monday (Sept 14), starting at 7pm.** MCC is joining with a national advocacy organization, Citizens for Public Justice (CPJ), to promote their recently-published book, *A Renewed Canadian Welcome*. At a time when government cuts are limiting options for bringing people to safety in Canada, and reducing the support they can receive in finding a future here, the authors call for a shift of policy towards welcome. Through a mix of telling peoples' stories and policy analysis, the message is proclaimed that Canadian national policy should centre lived experience and uphold our international obligations. We will hear from CPJ's executive director, two of the contributors to the book, and an Afghan woman who has applied to bring her family, and there will be an opportunity to ask questions and discuss.
